# FIRST HOLY COMMUNION

## PARTNERSHIP: HOME, SCHOOL & PARISH

#### **PARISH**

- ➤ Offer parents time to reflect on the importance of the two sacraments the child is preparing for and how best to support the child.
- ➤ Pray for the children of First Communion class at Sunday Mass.
- Have a Service of Light Ceremony in the parish.
- ➤ Frequent school visitation to support pupils and teachers.
- ➤ Home visitation.
- ➤ Decorate the church appropriately for the two sacraments.

## **HOME**

- ➤ Show an active interest in your child's religious work and preparation.
- ➤ Encourage the children to learn the stories in Alive O 4
- ➤ Accompany the child to Mass for months prior to First Holy Communion.
- ➤ Teach the child the prayers for First Penance and First Holy Communion.
- ➤ Talk to them about what they are doing at school. Discuss the themes they are covering at the time: e.g. Being Me, Being Us. Not Being Bothered, Not Being True. Being a Bully, Being Unfair, Being Selfish.
- Light a candle at teatime and get the child to say a prayer.
- ➤ Give the child the gift of a Children's Bible.

  Read Bible stories to the child, especially the ones they are doing in school.
- > Pray at home: Night Prayer, Grace before/after Meals, pray in the car.
- ➤ Share your memories of First Penance/Holy Communion with your child.
- Practice your own faith regularly and encourage your child to do likewise.
- Continue to lead by example.

## **SCHOOL**

- ➤ Provide the children with prayer experiences.
- ➤ Tell them Bible stories about the life of Jesus.
- ➤ Prepare some art on the various themes: Mass: The Last Supper, Sharing a Meal, Listening to God's Word and the various aspects of Forgiveness.
- Prepare the hymns for First Penance and First Holy Communion.
- ➤ Encourage the children to share some Communion money with children in undeveloped countries.
- ➤ Decorate the church for Penance and First Holy Communion.
