St. Valentine – Prayer Service

The feast is worth celebrating as it reminds students that all love is a reflection of God's love for us. St. Valentine was a bishop in the early church. He performed Christian marriages for young couples. There was a prohibition on all marriages at the time except those recognised by the state. Valentine was jailed. While in jail, he is believed to have cured the jailer's daughter of blindness. Just before he died he wrote her a letter which he signed "Your Valentine" Because of this he has become the patron saint of love.

{*Prior to the Prayer Service: invite the children to make a Valentine card for a parent or grandparent - these can be used at the service.*}

Sacred Space:

A cloth, candle, taper, matches, bible and the Valentine cards the children have made for parents, grandparents.

Opening Prayer:

God of love, you give us St. Valentine as an example of love. As we gather to celebrate the feast of this loving and caring saint we ask you to bless our friendships. May the love and affection we share with each other, always come from a sense of care and respect. May we always follow the example of your Son, Jesus Christ, who is Lord forever and ever. Amen.

Reading: 1John 4:7-12

Gospel: John 3:16-17
