

In this Sunday's Gospel Jesus responsibility gives the spreading His kingdom on earth to the eleven apostles and to us in turn. "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age." This was a tall order for the eleven who had little education or resources to help them in their task but with Spirit guiding them they travelled and preached and many were martyred for their beliefs. Today we think we are well

educated and every possible form of communication is open to us. but the Good News is more difficult to hear than ever. We need to have a committed, personal relationship with Jesus and be living our lives as a witness to Jesus teachings to begin with. We don't have to be perfect; even the apostles had doubts but we need to be at one with Jesus in our hearts and lives. Over the years manv religious travelled distant to places to bring the Good News and their work is now being blessed in many countries where the Church is flourishing. For many of us that option is not possible so our mission is to those whom we live with, work with and engage with on a daily basis. This can be a daily challenge especially when we try to love our enemies love unconditionally but this is what Jesus is expecting of us. This Sunday, we thank Jesus for allowing us to be participants in creating His kingdom on earth, for giving meaning to our lives here and for giving us the courage to go out as the apostles did and proclaim His Word. As we work for the Kingdom of God let us remember Jesus' words "And remember. I am with you always. to the end of the age".
