Airborne Survey to Gather Geophysical Data. The Tellus survey, is a national program working on behalf of Geological Survey Ireland (GSI) which gathers geochemical and geophysical data across Ireland. It will shortly commence an airborne survey across counties Kerry, north-west Cork and neighbouring Limerick. As the aircraft will fly at low altitude of 60 metres over rural areas, it may startle sensitive livestock. They are keen to inform and engage with as many organisations as possible to help raise awareness of the survey activity. More information on www.tellus.ie
