Airborne Survey to Gather Geophysical Data. The Tellus survey, is a national program working on behalf of Geological Survey Ireland (GSI) which gathers geochemical and geophysical data across Ireland. It will shortly commence an airborne survey across counties Kerry, north-west Cork and neighbouring Limerick. As the aircraft will fly at low altitude of 60 metres over rural areas, it may startle sensitive livestock.
