Day for Life 2024 will be celebrated this Sunday, June 16th, with the theme *The Lord is my shepherd - Compassion and Hope at the End of Life*. This year's message reminds us that Jesus did not send the sick away, rather He showed that life always has dignity and that there is no such thing as a useless life. On this Day for Life, conscious in a particular way of the gift of human life which is entrusted to our care, we bring our prayers to God.

1. We pray for Pope Francis, as he himself bears witness to hope in the frailty of his advanced years – that the Lord may strengthen him and give him courage to complete the mission for which he has been sent. Lord, hear us.
