This Sunday is the tenth Sunday in ordinary time. In the First Reading from the book of Genesis, we see God confronting Adam and Eve after they ate the fruit from the forbidden tree. Because of their disobedience, they would face the consequences of their actions, where once there was peace and harmony, now it was replaced by fear and disunity. God gave Adam and Eve the gift of free will, to choose to do what is right. However, they chose evil. They were ashamed and hid from God. they couldn't face Him. It wasn't God who brought this punishment on them, thev brought it on themselves. But, God takes pity on them and promises to send them a saviour and the Gospel shows promise fulfilled in Jesus. Jesus came to save the world from sin and death. When we look around at our world today, there is disunity, war, conflict,

divided world. In the Gospel Jesus says that a kingdom which is divided cannot stand. We have free will and within each of us is the capacity for good and evil, light and darkness. Whenever that happens, it causes division and a rift in our relationship with God. Through the Sacrament Reconciliation we restore our friendship with God. Our life on this earth is short, we must always keep our focus on the eternal. St Paul in the second reading puts it well, 'For we know that when the tent that we live in on earth is folded up, there is a house built by God for us, an everlasting home not made of hands. the human heavens'. Jesus is the Way, the Truth and the Life – keep our eyes on Him, only He can give the precious of gift of peace.
