An Airborne Survey To Gather Geophysical Data.

The Tellus survey, is a national programme working on behalf of **Geological Survey Ireland (GSI)** gathering geochemical and geophysical data across Ireland.

The Tellus team will shortly commence an airborne survey to gather geophysical data across counties Kerry, north-west Cork and neighbouring Limerick.

Given the aircraft will fly at a low altitude of **60 metres over rural areas** and may startle sensitive livestock, we are keen to inform and engage with as many organisations as possible to help raise awareness of the survey activity.
