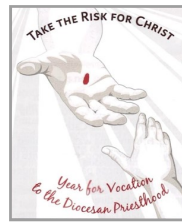

Introduction to the Scripture Readings
Jeremiah 23:1-6 — Shepherds who neglect
 their flocks are condemned, as God promises
 to intervene for the sake of the people — just
 as a good shepherd would do.
Ephesians 2:13-18 — Christ, by his blood,
 ends hostility and brings people together.
Mark 6:30-34 — Jesus en-
 courages the apostles to rest,
 but takes pity on the people
 also.

**Seeing Your Life Though
 The Lens Of The Gospel,**
Mk 6:30-34

1.The apostles reported to Jesus all that they
 had done and taught. Perhaps you have had
 the experience of being able to check in
 with somebody and share an experience.
 What have you learned from such conversa-
 tions.

2.Jesus saw that the apostles needed to rest
 and eat. What has been your experience of
 finding a restful place after a busy day? What
 kind of nourishment have you found
 necessary in order to maintain energy and
 enthusiasm?

3.When Jesus saw the crowd, he recognised
 their need and reached out to them. Who has
 been a Jesus person for you, someone who
 recognised your need and reached out to you?
 For whom have you been a Jesus person in
 that way?

4.It sometimes can be difficult to strike a
 balance between responding to the needs of
 others and meeting our need for rest and
 nourishment. What has helped you to keep the
 balance right?

Plenary Indulgence for the Faithful
 In a move to foster devotion among the
 faithful, Pope Francis has granted a Plenary
 Indulgence for the faithful who take part in the
 World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly.
 and all faithful who participate in the solemn
 celebration presided over by the Pope in St.
 Peter's Basilica, as well as to all those who
 attend Mass in various parts of the world. or
 through television, radio or the web. The same
 Plenary Indulgence applies to those who
 dedicate significant time to visit either in-
 person or by virtual means of communication
 their elderly brothers and sisters who are in
 need or facing difficulties, such as the sick,
 abandoned, and those with disabilities.
 For people who are unable to leave their homes
 due to serious reasons, spiritual participation in
 Mass celebrated for the World Day through
 prayer, offering their sufferings, and joining in
 the broadcasts of the Pope's various
 celebrations will also grant them the opportuni-
 ty to obtain a plenary indulgence.
 However, the indulgence requires that the faith-
 ful maintain detachment from sin and intend to
 fulfill the three usual conditions as soon as pos-
 sible. The indulgence is subject to the usual
 conditions of **Sacramental Confession, recep-
 tion of the Eucharist, and prayer for the in-
 tentions of the Holy Father.**
