Éigse Seán Ó Súilleabháin 2024 - Keeping The **Past Alive**

Are you interested in genealogy, or is there someone in your family who is great at remembering the previous generations? Then we want to hear from you!

Éigse Seán Ó Súilleabháin 2024 will be a social history project, called Keeping The Past Alive. It will have several small events. The first is at the Graveyard Mass on July 8th where we would like to invite anyone visiting a grave in the old graveyard to record details of that family burial on a special form we have prepared. We know that with every passing year, valuable information is lost and we want to capture what we can, to save it for future generations of Tuosist residents and visitors. Mass starts at 8pm, we will be there from 7pm to talk to people before and again after Mass and to assist with the form filling. During July we would like to invite people to come together to look at old census forms from 1901 and 1911. We are planning to hold these meetings valley by valley, so that people can share their memories and knowledge. The first one will cover the Gurranes area and will be advertised here in the weeks to come. Our aim is to link the families recorded in the census to a map of the houses in the area, and where possible to identify links to current families.
