Reflection ~Sharing is caring

"Sharing is caring" is something we teach our young children to put into practice. Throughout his ministry Jesus was attentive to those who hungered for healing, acceptance, for justice and for peace. He responded generously to these hungers. Today, the gospel speaks of Jesus being attentive to the hungry and exhausted. With the generosity of the young child Jesus responded to their plight and satisfied their need.

Today, these same hungers exist in our midst, especially those crying out for the basic necessities of life. We see this in Africa, Ukraine, the Middle East, and indeed even in our own country. The Lord invites us to be attentive to these hungers and like the young child to respond generously. God can do great things with our humble offerings. I am reminded of the saying of St Basil the Great (330-379 AD) that 'the bread which you do not use is the bread of the hungry, the clothes hanging in your closet is the garment of the one who is naked, the shoes that you do not wear are the shoes of the one who is barefoot, the money you keep locked away is the money of the poor.
