## Week beginning 18th August 2024

20th Sunday in Ordinary Time B



This Sunday's Gospel will be the fourth time the Gospel of 6<sup>th</sup> chapter John's proclaimed over the preceding three Sundays. The theme is the same: Jesus is the bread of life. Jesus addresses the crowd with these words, "I am the living bread which has come down from Heaven, anyone who eats this bread will live forever." Many of those who were listening were confused and abhorred at the idea of drinking human blood and flesh. eating human Δς Catholics, we think of the **Eucharist and the Consecration** at Mass when we hear Jesus' words. The Eucharist is the food for our soul where we eat the Body and drink the Blood of our Saviour. Each time we receive the Lord when the priest says, "Body of Christ" (in Latin: Corpus Christi) we say "Amen." Maybe we could be more enthusiastic and active in

our Amen. "Amen" or "Yes or I believe" is more than just a response; it implies that we accept and receive Jesus, Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity, His Gospels, His Commandments, His joys and His sufferings with our whole heart and our whole soul. When we receive the "Bread of Life" we are totally united with Jesus Christ because He has made Himself the Bread of Life. It gives new meaning to our lives because Jesus is in us and we are now working with Him, trying to spread His kingdom here on earth. At the end of Mass, we are asked to go and serve the Lord by the living the Gospel with our life; maybe we could make an extra special effort during the week to chat with a lonely person, to pray with a little child, say a kind word to a stranger and be gentle with those we find difficult.

So, this Sunday we thank God for the Eucharist and for His coming to us at every Mass. We ask Him to make us worthy to receive Him and to respond generously to Him through our daily living out His Word of Truth, Faith, Hope, and Charity.
