

Today in St. John's Gospel Jesus tells us, "I am the Bread of Life, he who comes to me will never hunger: he who believes in me will never thirst." Our whole Faith is centred around the Eucharist, the Bread of Life, Jesus truly present body and blood, a gift from God our heavenly Father to us in order to save us from our sinfulness.
