**Moving Forward in Hope – Bishop Ray's**

**Pastoral Letter:** There is a Pastoral Letter from Bishop Ray which provides an overview of the ongoing journey within the diocese this year. It also outlines the next steps for parishes and pastoral areas. Copies are available at the back of the church. Please take one to read.

**St Kilian** was born in Mullagh, Co. Cavan in 640 A.D., left Ireland from **Kilmackilloge, Tuosist**, and was martyred in Wurzburg, Germany in 689. His relics are visiting Mullagh and Cavan on Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup>, with the days marked by Masses, processions, a concert, and times for veneration. You might like to be part of the historic visit – Mullagh is about an hour from Dublin and 15 mins from Kells Co. Meath. **Éigse Seán Ó Súilleabháin 2024 is a social history project, called Keeping the Past Alive.**

We know that with every passing year, valuable information is lost and we want to capture what we can, to save it for future generations of Tuosist residents and visitors. We will be going through each townland in turn to look at old census forms and old maps. Our aim is to link the families recorded in the census to a map of the houses in the area, and where possible to identify links to current families.

The next event is a talk at the **Parish Hall on Saturday 28 September** at 7pm with Mike Riney from Gleninchaquin and Lynn Zaback from New York who have run a huge research project, the Tuosist Research Tree. This parish tree holds thousands of records of Tuosist people on both sides of the Atlantic, with the family trees of every family listed in this area in the 1901 census included. Come along and hear how this project started, what information it contains, and what the future plans are, to share access to this amazing resource.

Finally, a **Gurranes** focus meeting will be held at Lauragh Community Centre on **Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> September** at 2pm, again looking at old census forms and old maps, in order to link these records together and make sense of them and how they link to modern day households.
