St Killian was born in Mullagh, Co. Cavan in 640 AD, left Ireland from **Killmacillogue**, **Tuosist Parish**, and was martyred in Wurzburg, Germany in 689. His relics are visiting Mullagh and Cavan on Oct 3rd to 6th, with the days marked by Masses, processions, a concert, and times for veneration.
