<u>Feast of St. John Paul II</u> is celebrated on Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> October. He was pope for over twenty six years from 1978 to 2005. He visited Ireland in 1979.

Feast of Blessed Taidhg Mac Carthaigh (1566-1602) is celebrated on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> October. When he was made Bishop of Cork and Cloyne, the then Earl of Desmond demanded that his appointment be confirmed by the Pope. He travelled to Rome as a pilgrim but on his return journey to Ireland he died in the town of Ivrea in Italy where he is still venerated as the 'Irish Saint'.
