Catholic Bishops' Pastoral Letter welcoming migrants to Ireland

On Sunday 13th October 2024, the Bishops of Ireland are publishing a Pastoral Letter – *A Hundred Thousand Welcomes?* – to welcome migrants to Ireland. As Christians, we have a responsibility to respond to the key question of immigration across our island, and the world. This fundamental question asks, 'who is my neighbour?' and to answer this we are informed by the parable of the Good Samaritan (Luke 10: 29-37). In the light of the Gospel and Catholic Social Teaching, our bishops offer this reflection on what hospitality for migrant people means in contemporary Ireland.
