It is easy to overlook the motive behind giving and focus, not on the giver, but on the gift. We do have the expression that it's the thought that counts. Usually, though, such proverbial wisdom is employed to help me/us be consoled when some expectation was not realised. Thus, this apparently consolatory thought acknowledges the tendency to the opposite, the attraction to the gift as such!! When we give, help us remember that you love the cheerful giver, giving from the heart.*
