A NOTE FROM FR JIM.....

I heard a story once of a frightened patient who before a major surgery asked his doctor what the next world was like. And the doctor hesitated for a while and said 'honestly I'm not sure'. The patient in frustration said, you a Christian man and you an educated man and you don't know?!! Then suddenly the doctor's dog from next door started barking and scratching at the door of the new surgery and as soon as the doctor opened the door the dog bursts in and began jumping up on the doctor with great excitement. Then the doctor smiled and looked at his anxious patient and said wow this is my dog from my home next door. This is a brand new building in fact you are my first patient here and my dog was never inside this building before, yet he had no fear at all running in because he knew that the master who loved him was here.

The moral of this story reminds me of St. John's line 'Perfect love casts out all fear'. And also it reminds me of the 8th episode of the Metanoia program which is on in the Community Hub Barradubh on Sunday night @ 7pm. The name of the episode is 'Jesus' power over the Evil one'.
