CARLO ACUTIS (1991—2006): Franciscan Friary will welcome Bishop Ray Browne, as main celebrant on Sunday the 1st December at the 11.30am mass, and he will unveil a 1st Class Relic of Blessed Carlo. It's a privilege for us to have received this 1st Class Relic. This Relic will be on permanent display in this church and we pray that it will be venerated by many people, particularly the young over the years.

We also pray that it will bring many blessings not only to the young but all the people of Killarney, County Kerry and outlying areas. This Sunday, you will be able to venerate the Relic after the 11.30am mass, at 3.00pm in the afternoon (particularly for families and young children) and after the 7.00pm Triuum Mass for the Feast of St Francis Xavier on Sunday evening also.

Carlo who died at age 15 from leukaemia will be the first Millennial (person born in the early 1980s— to the late 1990s), to be canonised by the Catholic Church. The teenager has also been labelled as the Patrion Saint of the internet, and known as "God's Influencer", for his work on recording miracles online and running Websites for Catholic organisations. . First Miracle was the healing of a Brazilian Child and the Second a student in Florene who was healed despite having bleeding on the brain suffering head trauma. Pope Francis has announced that the Italian teenager will be made Saint April 2025.
