A Jubilee Year is held every twenty-five years. Pope Francis will officially open the year by opening a Holy Door in St Peter's Basilica, Rome on Christmas Eve. The beginning will be celebrated worldwide on the following Sunday, 29<sup>th</sup> December Feast Day of the Holy Family in every diocese worldwide, and thus at all our Masses that weekend. Pope Francis has chosen the Jubilee theme "Pilgrims of Hope". When we speak of 'Hope' we mean 'Hope in Jesus Christ', Hope in our God, Father, Son and Spirit.

We are asked to treat the year ahead as a year-long pilgrimage seeking together to become more aware that truly Jesus Christ Our Saviour is with us each day, as our help, strength and guide.

As part of the **Connecting Ireland Rural Mobility Plan, TFI Local Link Kerry** is launching a new bus service, which will improve connectivity between Castletownbere, Eyeries, Ardgroom, Lauragh, Tuosist and Kenmare, from Monday 30<sup>th</sup> December 2024. The Service will operate 4 daily return services Monday to Sunday. The establishment of this new Bus Service marks a significant milestone for the community, which up to now, has never had a public transport service 7 days a week.
