Today the second Sunday Advent we are again looking forward in joyful hope to the coming of Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. Advent is a time of waiting and preparing for His arrival. The Bible readings tell us when Jesus comes at the end of time, we will see the fulfilment of Gods promises when all things and people will be judged by Christ. While we wait, we are meant to repent and do reparation. In the St. Luke's Gospel today we are told John the Baptist is calling people to repent and prepare by fasting prayer and alms giving.
