*** Feast of Fra Angelico - 18 February ***

Fra Angelico (Patron Saint of Artists) was an Italian painter of the early Renaissance who combined the life of a devout friar with that of an accomplished painter. He was called Angelico (Italian for "angelic") and Beato (Italian for "blessed") because the paintings he did were of calm, religious subjects and because of his extraordinary personal piety. Angelico combined the influence of the elegantly decorative Gothic style with the more realistic style of the Renaissance. Angelico's representation of devout facial expressions and his use of colour to heighten emotion are particularly effective. His skill in creating monumental figures, representing motion, and suggesting deep space through the use of linear perspective, especially in the Roman frescoes, mark him as one of the foremost painters of the Renaissance. Visit the National Gallery in London to see CHRIST IN GLORY SURROUNDED BY SAINTS AND ANGELS one of his beautiful works. He died in the Dominican convent in Rome on March 18, 1455.
